Brake pads, rear wheel



Important


All rear brake pads must be replaced at the same time.

To remove

- 1 Raise the car.
- 2 Remove the wheel.
- 3 Remove the carrier from the brake caliper.
- 4 Remove the protective covers and slide pins. Lift off the hydraulic body.
- 5 Remove the inner brake pad from the caliper and the outer brake pad from the bracket.
 - Clean the inside of the brake caliper and check the dust covers.




6 Screw in the brake piston with 89 96 969 Resetting tool and 89 96 977 Adapter.

To fit

1 Apply 89 96 993 Special grease paste to the sliding areas and the contact surfaces.



2 Fit the brake pads.

Note


Make sure the springs on the inner pad enter the groove in the piston.



Tightening torque 28 Nm (21 lbf ft)

Fit the protective covers.


- 4 Fit the retaining spring to the brake caliper
- 5 Clean the contact surface between the rim and the brake disc from dirt and rust.



6 Apply 30 06 442 White high-pressure grease paste to the hub.

Important

Make sure there is no grease on the contact surface between the rim and the brake disc.




- 7 Put the wheel into position.
 - Fit the bolts and tighten them alternately by hand to centre the wheel.
- 8 Tighten the bolts twice alternately.

Important

The wheel must be suspended freely when tightening the wheel bolts.

Tightening torque 110 Nm (81 lbf ft)

- 9 Lower the car.
- 10 Press the brake pedal a few times to press out the brake pistons and the handbrake adjustment.
- 11 Check the brake fluid level and top up as necessary.
- 12 Check the operation of the foot brake and handbrake.
